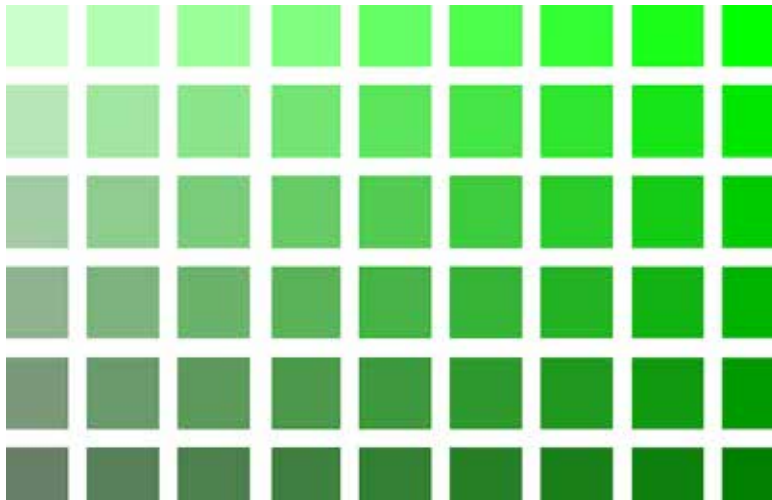

Take-Back

- A manufacturer, retailer or third-party designee program that takes back the product(s) at the end-of-life for:
 - Recycling
 - Remanufacturing
 - proper disposal consistent with environmental laws and regulations

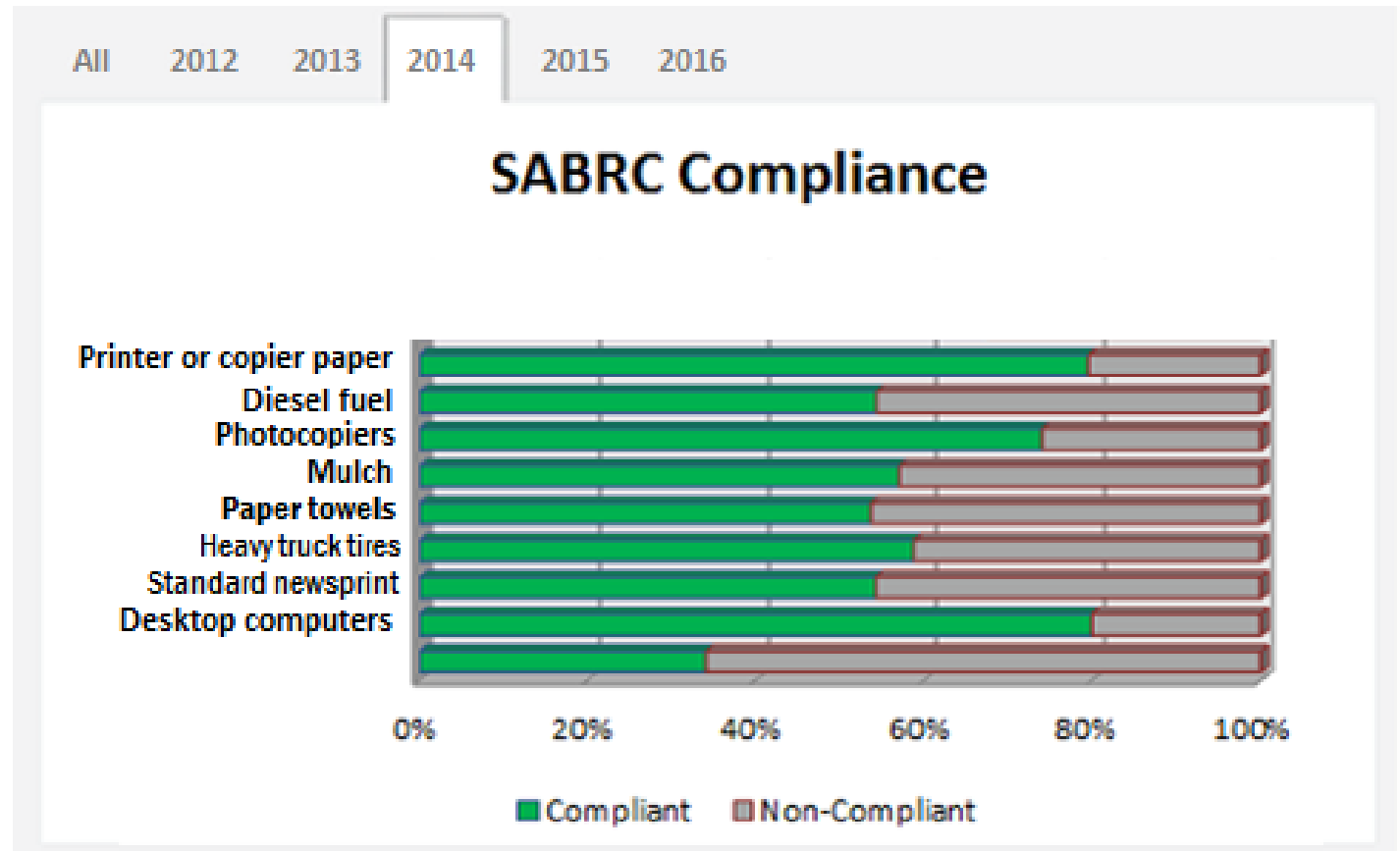
Tracking EPP in FI\$Cal

3. Tracking and reporting EPP progress

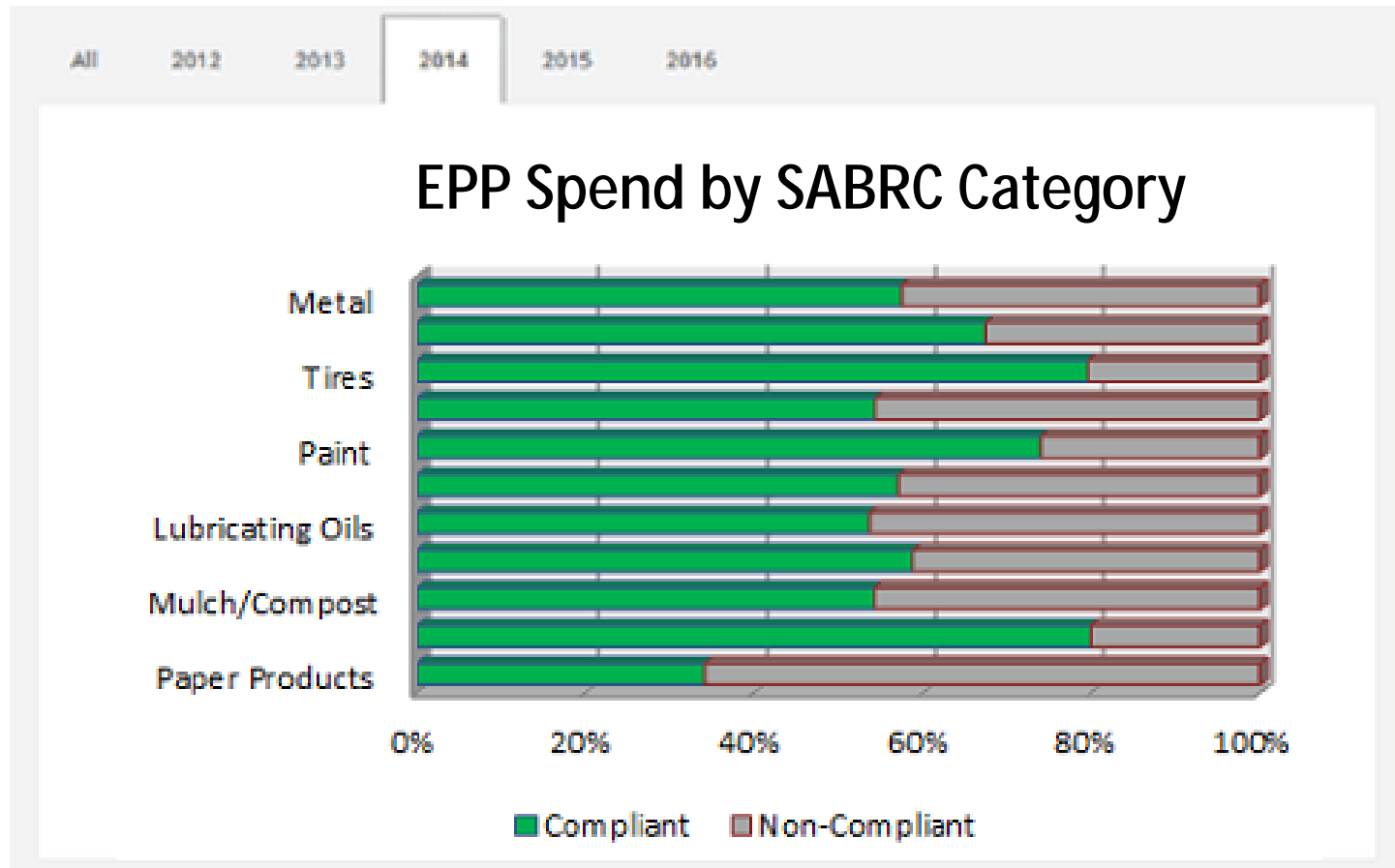

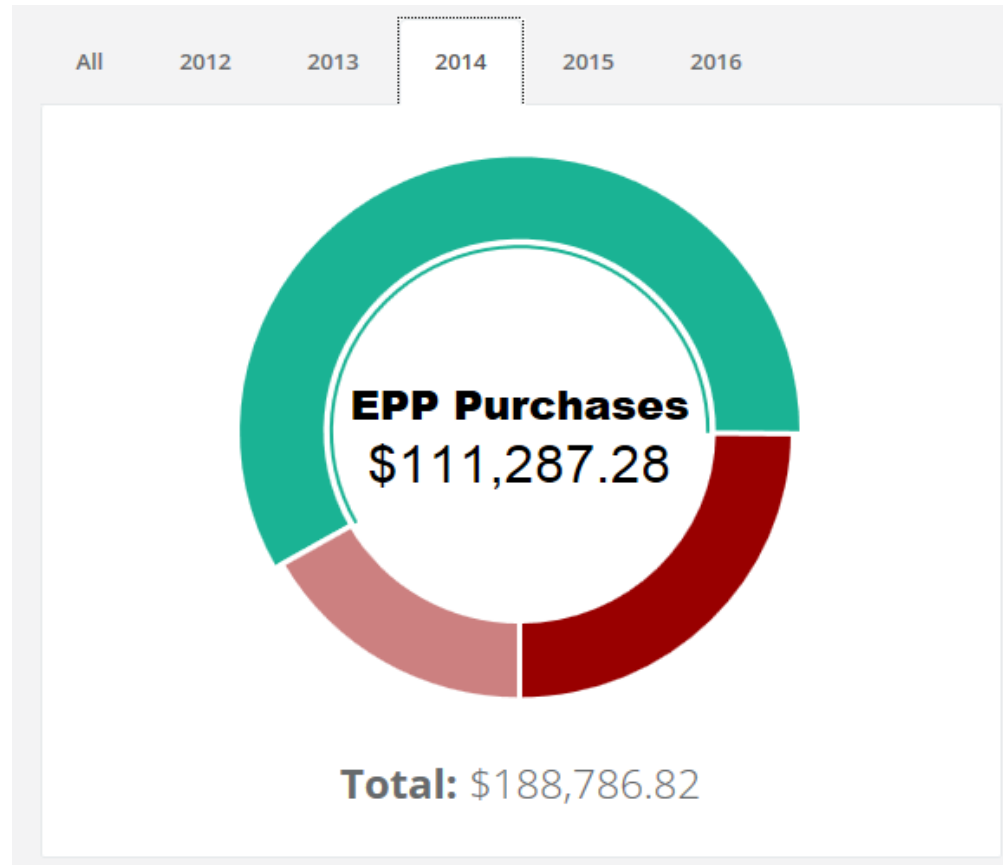
EPP Spend by UNSPSC
