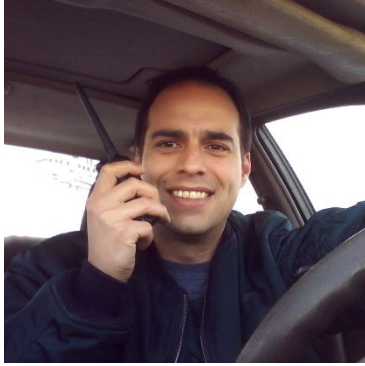


Jonathan Marquiss
